3. ICBC Road Safety Curriculum

Roberto Bombelli, Assistant Superintendent, shared information regarding ICBC's free educational resources for students in grades K-10. The *Road Safety Packages* for K-7 include resources such as *RoadSense Kids* (activities for learning road safety) and *Walk smart*, *Bike safe* (pedestrian and bike safety). The Road Safety Packages for grades 8-10 include Health & Career Education, and Planning 10 resources.

a) Eye See – Eye Learn

The Burnaby School District and the British Columbia Association of Optometrists (BCAO) have been partnering since April 2014 to provide an eye examination and free prescription eyeglass program for all kindergarten children. During the 2014-15 school year, 183 children received an eye exam, of which 38 received prescription eyewear. The program will be available again this school year and families can access this benefit until August 31, 2016.
